


Hull SEND Information, Advice & Support Service (SENDIASS)

Information & Advice

Hull SENDIASS provides **free**, **confidential**, **independent** and **impartial** information, advice and support to families of children and young people aged 0-25 years with SEND in Hull.

Our independently trained staff provide information, advice and support on:

- Your rights associated with SEND law, legislation and local policy
- Guidance on difference processes (such as EHC needs assessments, appeals and tribunals)
- Information on relevant organisation's processes for resolving disagreements, complaints and means of redress

Further Support

SENDIASS Practitioners can also help with:

- Face to face consultations to guide you through assessment, reviews and complaints paperwork
- Specific and focused support and representation in meetings with professionals, in mediations and at SENDIST Tribunals
