- **Guidance** on difference processes (such as EHC needs assessments, appeals and tribunals)
- Information on relevant organisation's processes for **resolving** disagreements, complaints and means of redress

- Face to face **consultations** to guide you through assessment, reviews and complaints paperwork
- Specific and **focused support** and representation in meetings with professionals, in mediations and at SENDIST Tribunals
