

School Placements

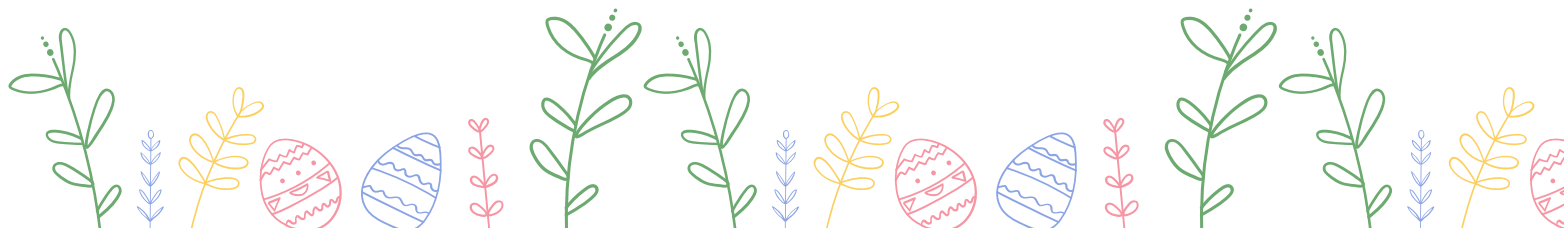
School placements will be announced on the 15th of April, once you have your space please let a member of staff know.
