What we're doing this month

Valentines Day

Creating heart-themed art using handprints, bubble painting, around a stencil, or general messy fun with brushes and sponges as well.

We are also looking at Pet day and have asked parents to bring in photos of their pets and the children can tell us about them. Red bubble is learning BSL so that they can communicate with all of their friends.

Story Telling Week

We will be reading books like Going on a Bear Hunt and use instruments or household objects to create sounds for the actions (e.g., rustling paper for long grass, splashing water for the river)

We are also focusing on the classics like The Three Little Pigs or Goldilocks, using puppets and masks for role-play as well as dressing up as the character in the stories.

Maths

Practice writing numbers in various ways in rice, flour, sand, paints.

We will also be looking at number, shape and colour sorting and using sensory trays to empty and fill containers.

We will be also be using magnetic bricks to count and learn the colours of the bricks.

Random Act of Kindness

We will be learning about sharing and taking turns with our friends by using a sand timer .

Children can paint pictures for their friends which we will hide for them to find in the garden turning it into a fun hide and seek game.
